

# **HIGHLIGHTS**

- · Colorado (CO) uses HPP funding to build and maintain a strong emergency preparedness and response foundation for the state's 5.8 million residents.
- CO created a combined hospital transfer center with health care facilities and its emergency medical services division. The state plans to use this as a model to develop a similar entity for its pediatric centers to prevent bottlenecks for these limited resources moving forward.

# SPOTLIGHT ON RESPONSE

In March of 2021, the North Central Region Healthcare Coalition's (NCR HCC's) disaster mental health group coordinated the regional response to an active shooter event at a grocery store. The coordination focused on resource sharing, situational awareness, and long-term planning for recovery in support of the city and county of Boulder, mental health partners, the community mental health center, and victim advocates. The response was guided by the new behavioral health (BH) response plan initiated by NCR HCC BH partners.

### **COVID-19 RESPONSE**

- CO HCCs use weekly information sharing and situational awareness meetings, as well as qualitative data-sharing through member organizations, to build greater understanding of the impact of health and medical response decisions.
- Colorado activated <u>crisis standards of</u> care statewide to outline how the medical community should allocate scarce resources to help hospitals implement staffing solutions to best meet the increasing medical needs of their communities.
