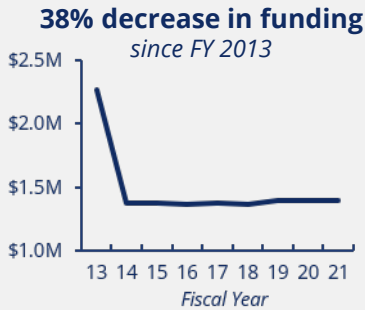

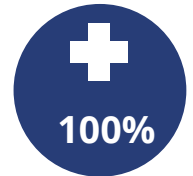
HPP FUNDING



HPP HIGHLIGHTS

- Nebraska (NE) uses HPP funding to improve its emergency preparedness and response foundation for its nearly two million residents.
- The NE HPP provided the entire state with personal protective equipment (PPE) during the COVID-19 response.
- NE HPP drafted statewide crisis standards of care that were legislatively adopted to aid health care facilities in making critical care decisions during times of crisis.

of public health agencies



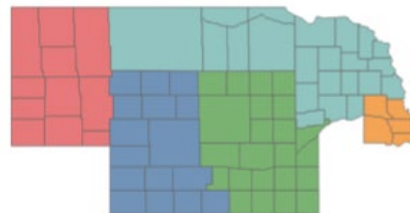

HPP SPOTLIGHT ON RESPONSE

NE HPP purchased bilevel positive airway pressure machines (BiPAP) for health care coalitions (HCCs) to distribute to health care facilities. The 20 BiPAP machines assisted in keeping intensive care unit ventilator use down and providing improved patient care to those with respiratory issues. The distribution and use of these machines saved hundreds of beds and allowed ventilators to go to the patients most in need.

COVID-19 RESPONSE

- NE administered a statewide information-sharing system. This system allowed for a collaborative approach to patient care and supply management.
- NE HCCs coordinated staff sharing efforts to ease staff shortages. Coalitions coordinated the move of available, trained, and ready staff to facilities with quarantine-based need in order to assure adequate patient coverage.
- NE HCCs provided training and educational opportunities for nurses to expand their scope and fill staffing needs.
