- Comparison of multiple facilities

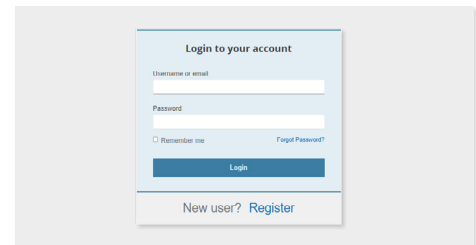

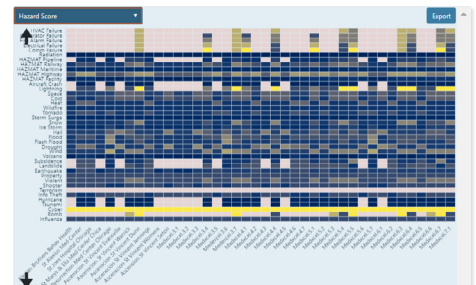
Facilities
